- The Organising committee reserves the right to adopt suitable procedures and changes, if any are required and the decision of the Executive Board (EB) would be final and conclusive. No grievance with respect to their decision will be entertained. Participants creating any kind of indiscipline will be disqualified at the discretion of the EB.
- Participants thereby should adhere to the rules and regulations of the event.

- Any bonafide high-school student, who is currently in any grade ranging from 9th to 12th in a recognised school, and;
- Any bonafide student, who is enrolled in any undergraduate programme in any recognised College/ University/ Institution, can register for "Bharat Ratna Late Shri. Atal Bihari Vajpayee MNLU-CS 3rd National Youth Parliament, 2025."

ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

- 2. No pick-up and drop facility shall be provided to any of the participants from the Airport/Bus station/Railway station. Participants shall have to make their own arrangements for reaching the Campus.


